2024 SHOW SCHEDULE

Saturday, October 12, 2024:

- All entries must be postmarked by Saturday, October 12, 2024 to avoid the \$2 per bird late fee. All entries must be mailed to: Josh Zilles PO BOX 1704 Idaho Falls, Idaho 83403

Thursday, October 17, 2024:

- All Entries need to be received by Thursday, October 17, 2024 at Midnight if you want to show your birds at the 2024 Salt Lake Premier.

Thursday, October 31, 2024:

- Show Set up will start at 8:00 am at the Deseret Peak Complex. All Specialty clubs must have at least one representative that will work the entire duration of setup.
- The Show Hall will be closed at 6:00 pm. Specialty clubs may setup their judging areas and exhibitors can start cooping their birds once setup has been completed.
- Exhibitor Dinner will be served from 4pm to 6pm, Free to all those that entered birds in the show.

Friday, November 1, 2024:

- Show Hall Opens at 8:00 am
- All Birds must be cooped by 10:00 am and Judging will begin shortly after.
- Show Hall will Close at 6:00 pm

Saturday, November 2, 2024:

- Show Hall Opens at 8:00 am
- Junior Judging and Showmanship will start at 10:00 am
- All Breed Judging must be completed by 12:30 pm
- Raffle will start at 1:00 pm
- Live Auction will start at 2:00 pm
- Best in Show Judging will begin at 3:00 pm
- Awards will be presented after the Best in Show Judging is completed
- Birds may be boxed following the awards presentation. Once no birds are missing from the show your entries will be released.
- Show cleanup will follow the release of entries. All specialty clubs must have at least one representative that will work the entire duration of the cleanup.



2024 SHOW RULES

If you cannot abide by these rules, please do not enter as exceptions are seldom made and we want a peaceful and fun event for all!

1. The Utah Pigeon Club recognizes all reputable banding organization's seamless bands of the appropriate size.
2. The Utah Pigeon Club and sponsoring specialty clubs have selected responsible judges and as such their decisions are final.
3. The best security possible is provided to all entries; the Utah Pigeon Club and its officers are not responsible for the loss of any entries.
4. All entries must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor.
5. The show management team reserves the right to deny entries for not meeting the rules and to disqualify and/or remove any entries that appear to be unhealthy and a danger to other entries.
6. No pigeons will be allowed in the show hall for which an entry fee has not been paid, except for the birds selected for the Utah Pigeon Club auction.
7. No Birds will be allowed into the show hall that are from a County that is under quarantine with Newcastle Disease or any other disease
8. No pigeons will be allowed to leave the show hall prior to the general release without specific permission from the show management team and payment of the leave early fee.
9. Substitutions are only allowed when made within the same breed and must follow any rules of the sponsoring specialty club.
10. Judging may occur at any time during the show hours at the discretion of the sponsoring specialty club or the show management team.
11. The show management team has final say in all disputes and has the right to make exceptions to these rules on a case-by-case basis.
12. All birds must be cooped no later than 10:00 am on Friday, November 1. All birds will be released at 5:00 pm on Saturday, November 2 or when the Show Director releases the show.
13. No Judging areas will be set up until the show is 100% set up.
14. All Club Rebates and Entries must be signed before cooping birds.
15. Final Judging 3:00 pm owners bring their own birds to the showing station.




DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From Salt Lake City: Take I-80 West from SLC, take exit 94. Now traveling on Midde Valley Highway. Turn left onto to Sheep lane. The Complex is at the corner of Sheeplane and SR 112 and must be entered from SR 112.

From the South on SR 36: Coming into Tooele on SR 36 traveling North. SR 36 becomes Tooele's main street, turn left at street light 200 North. Proceed on 200 North out of Tooele and 200 North SR 112. The Complex is at the corner of Sheeplane and SR 112 and must be entered from SR 112.

1. Pairs must be submitted by Friday morning at 10 am. No pairs will be accepted after the deadline.
2. A minimum bid can be set by the breeder if desired. If minimum bids are not met, the breeder retains donated pair.
3. A silent auction book will be provided to allow bids to be taken Friday and Saturday during the show.
4. Any pair that has 5 or more bids on the silent auction will go to the live auction Saturday afternoon. Any book with 4 or less bids will be awarded to the highest written bidder.




